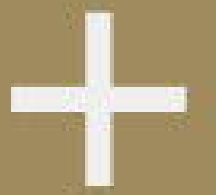

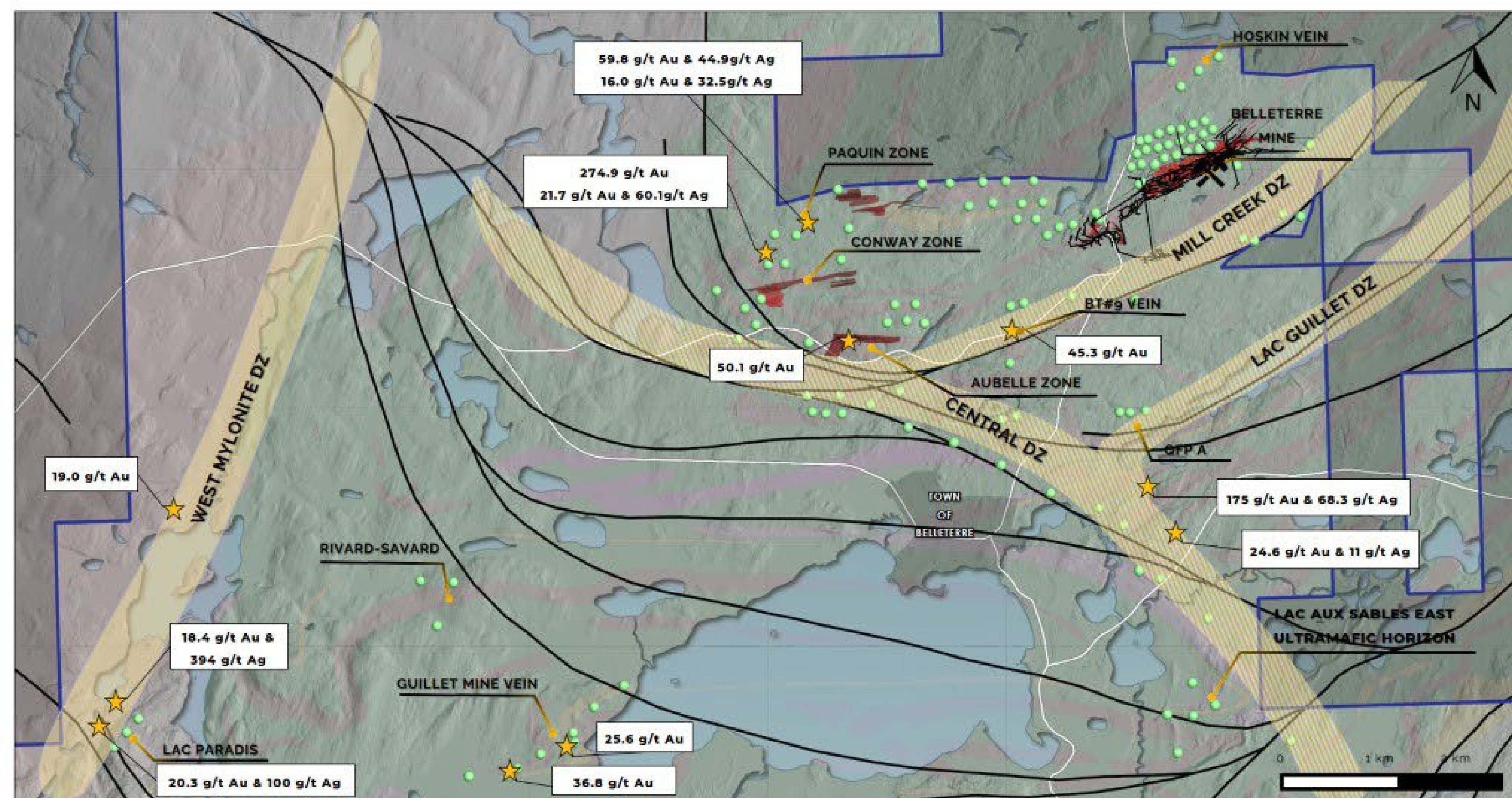

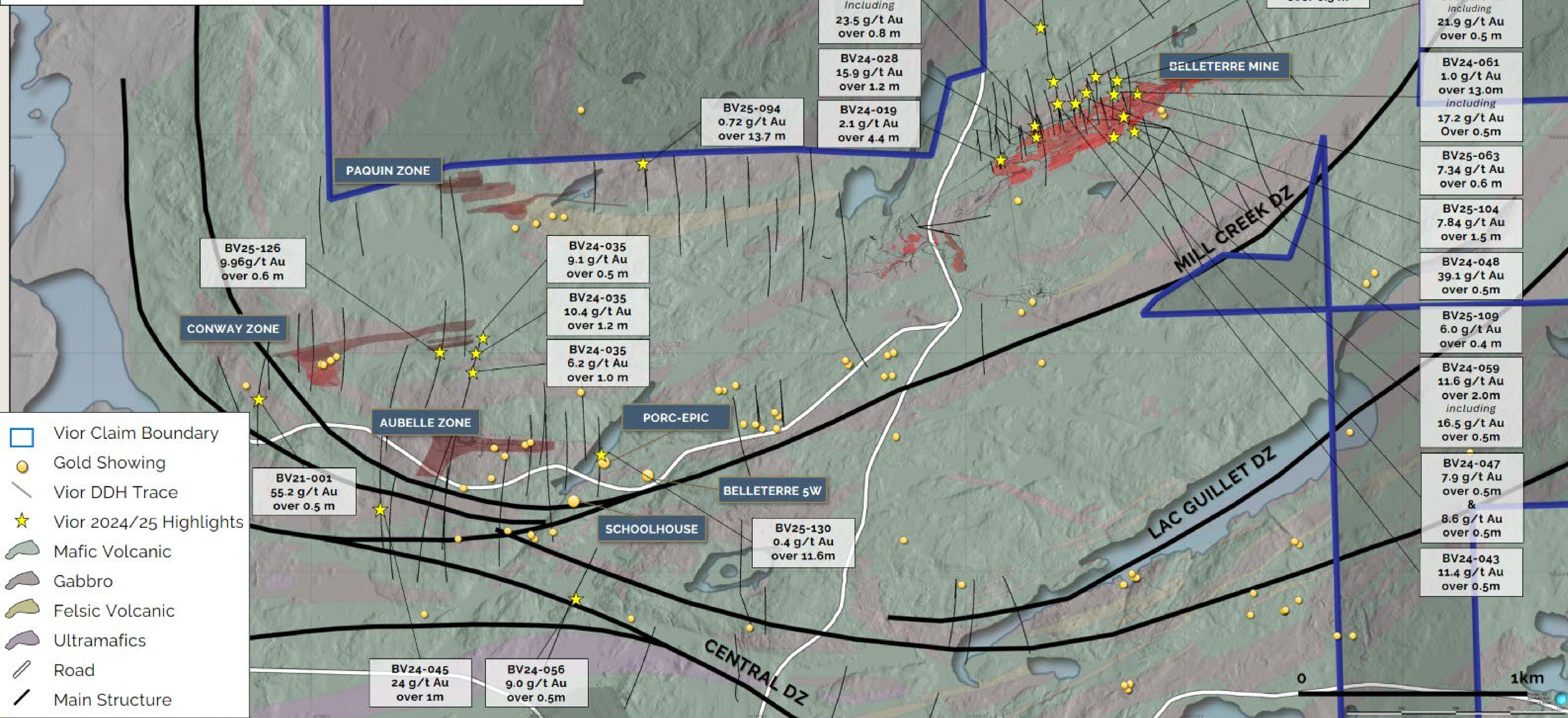

60,000m Drill Program



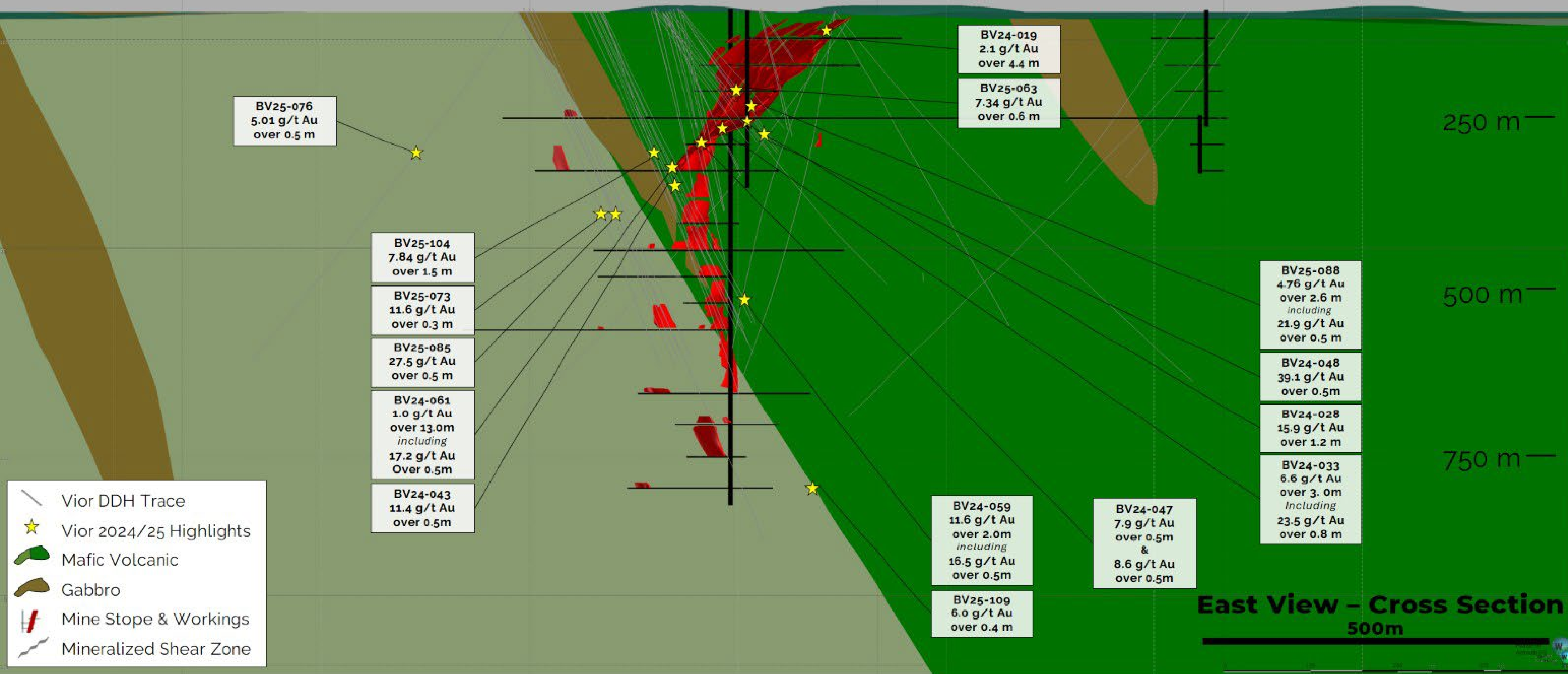

Plan Map - Assay Results



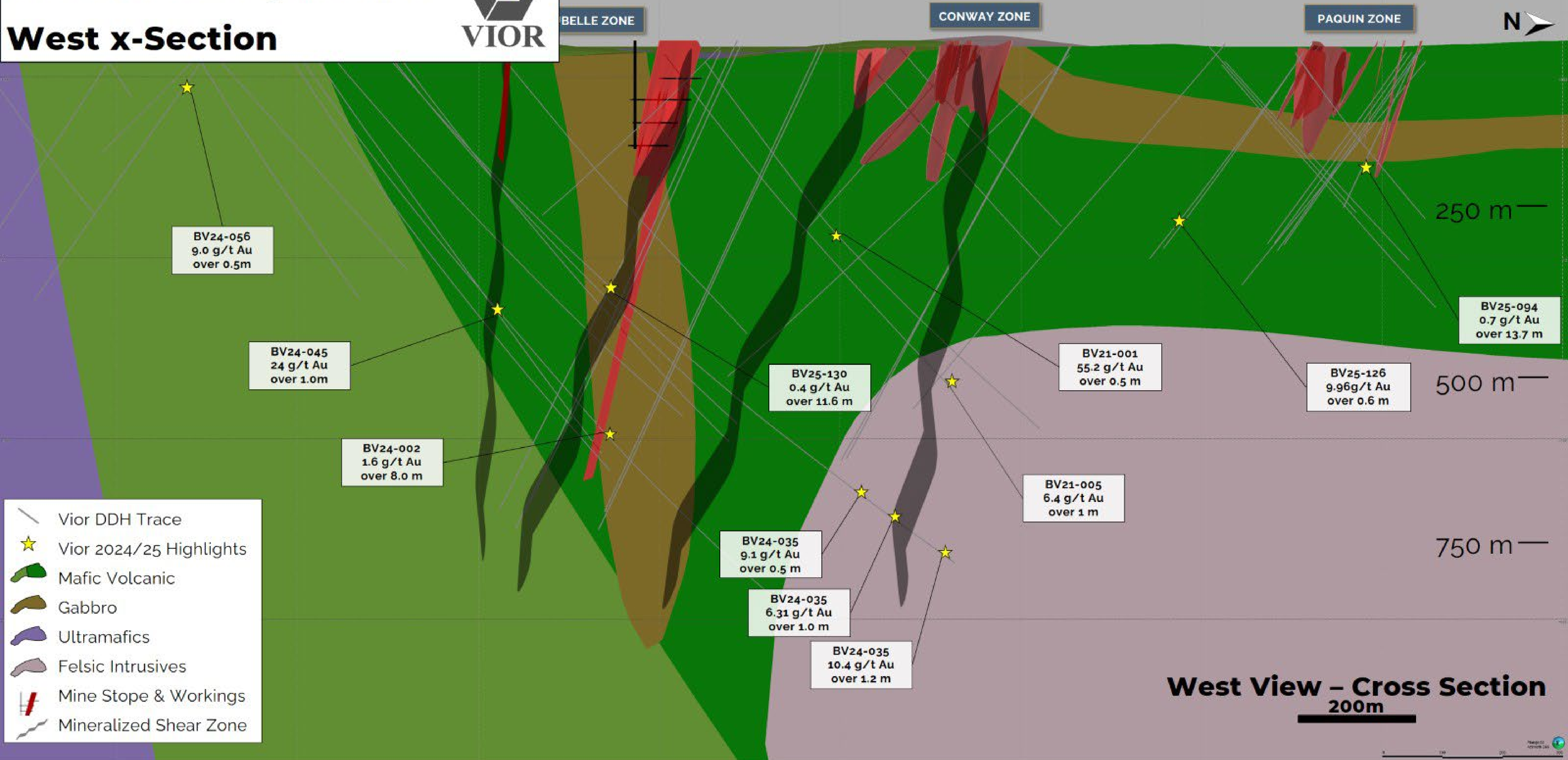
BT Mine Assay Results

East x-Section



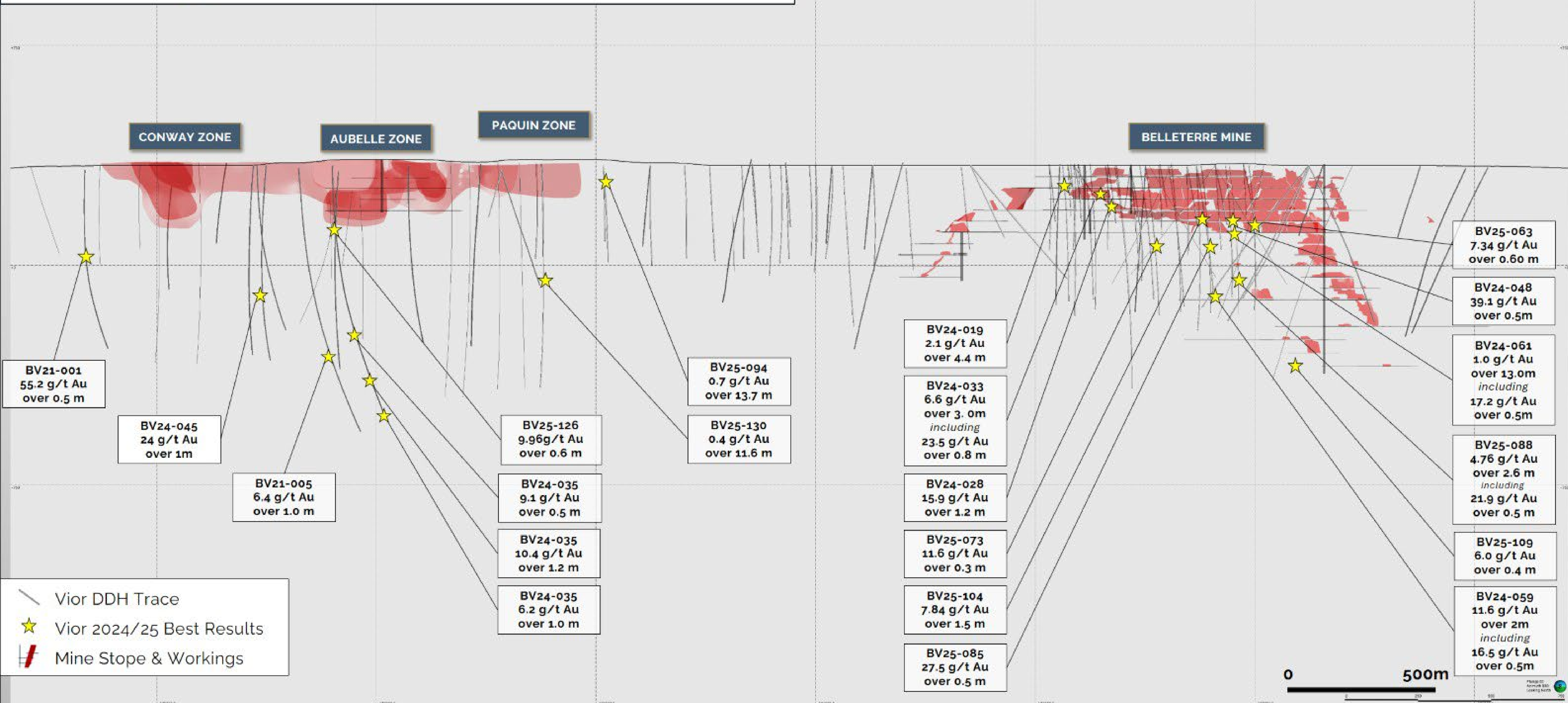
ACP Area Assay Results

West x-Section



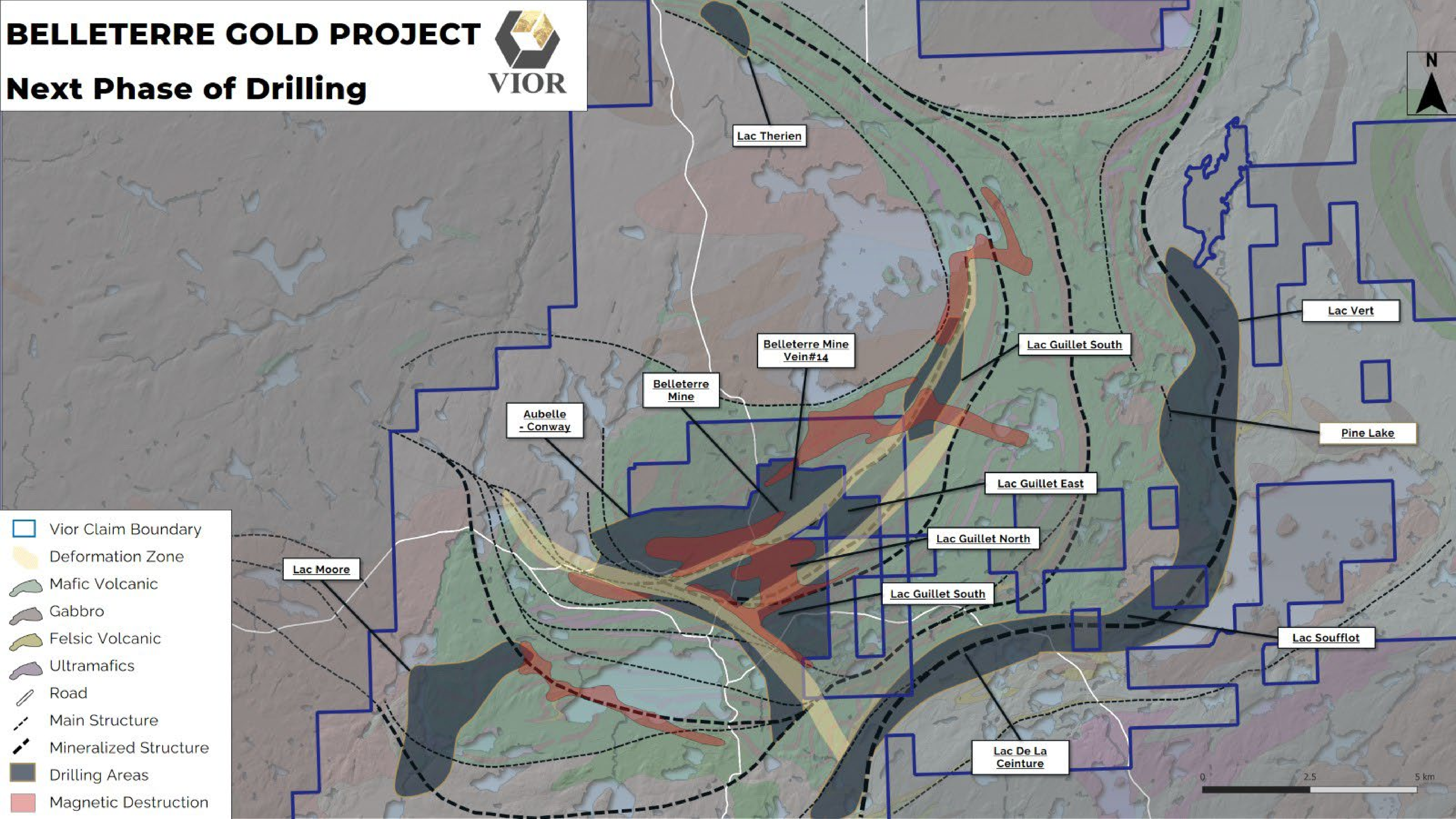

North Long-Section - DDH Results



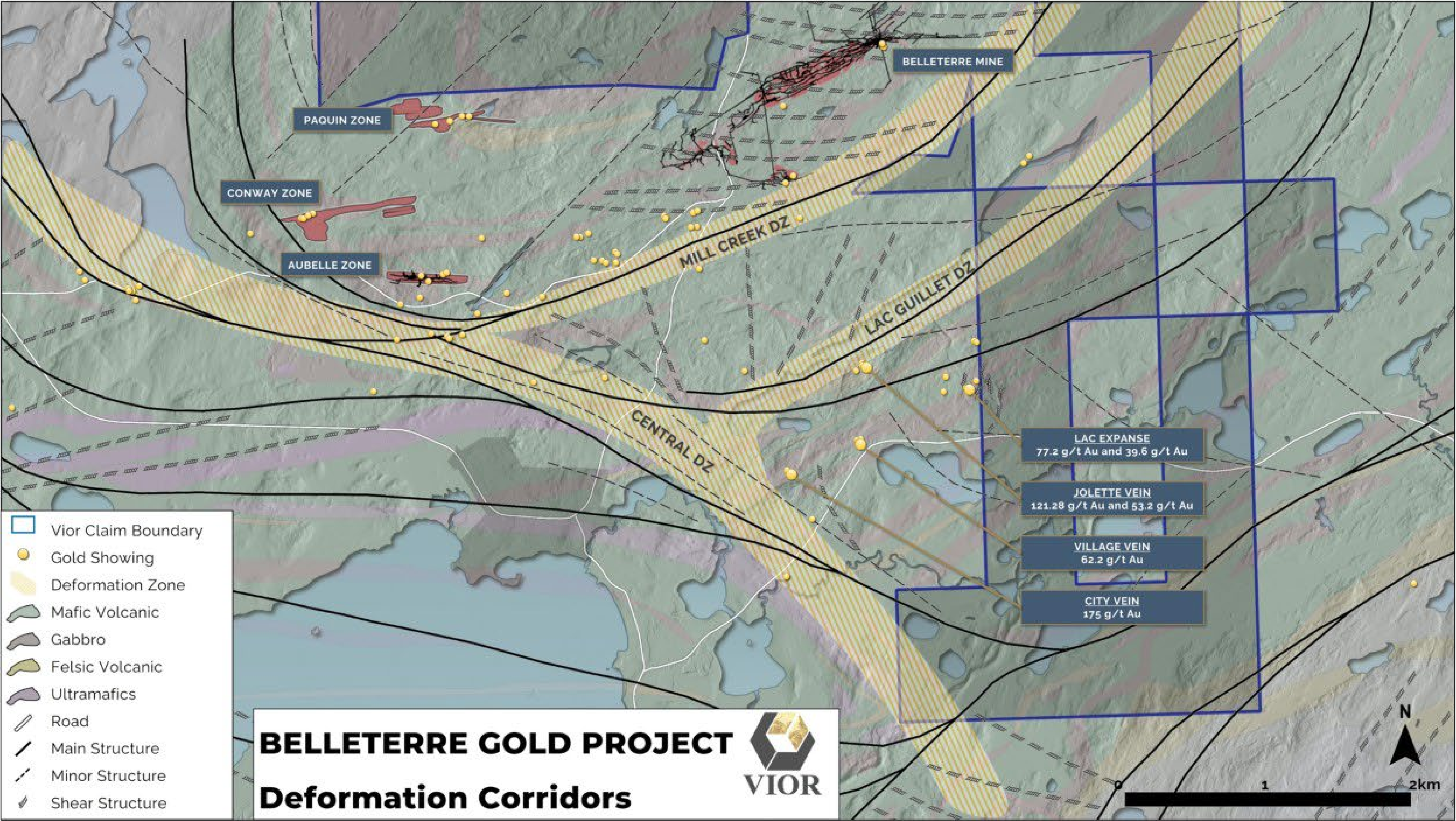

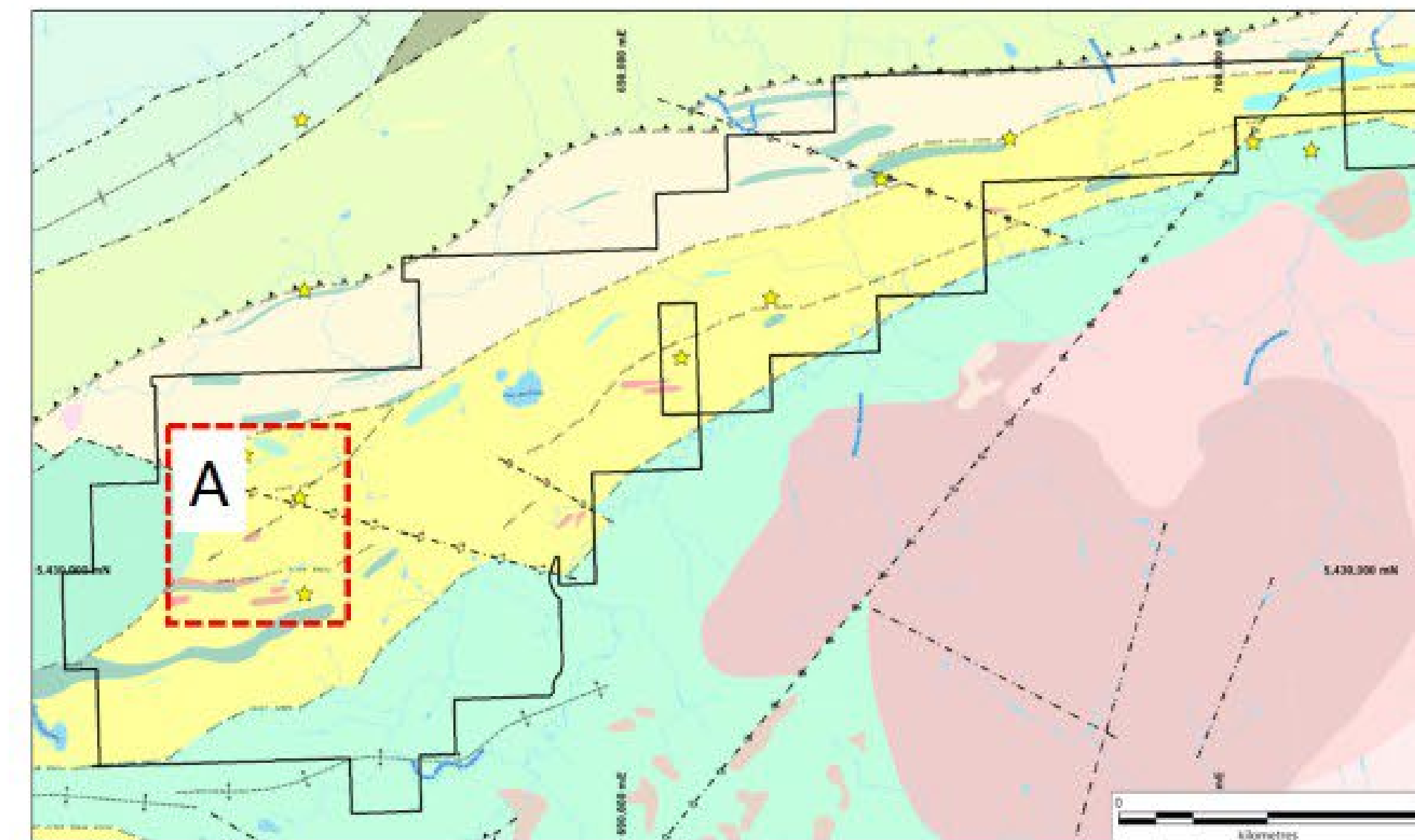
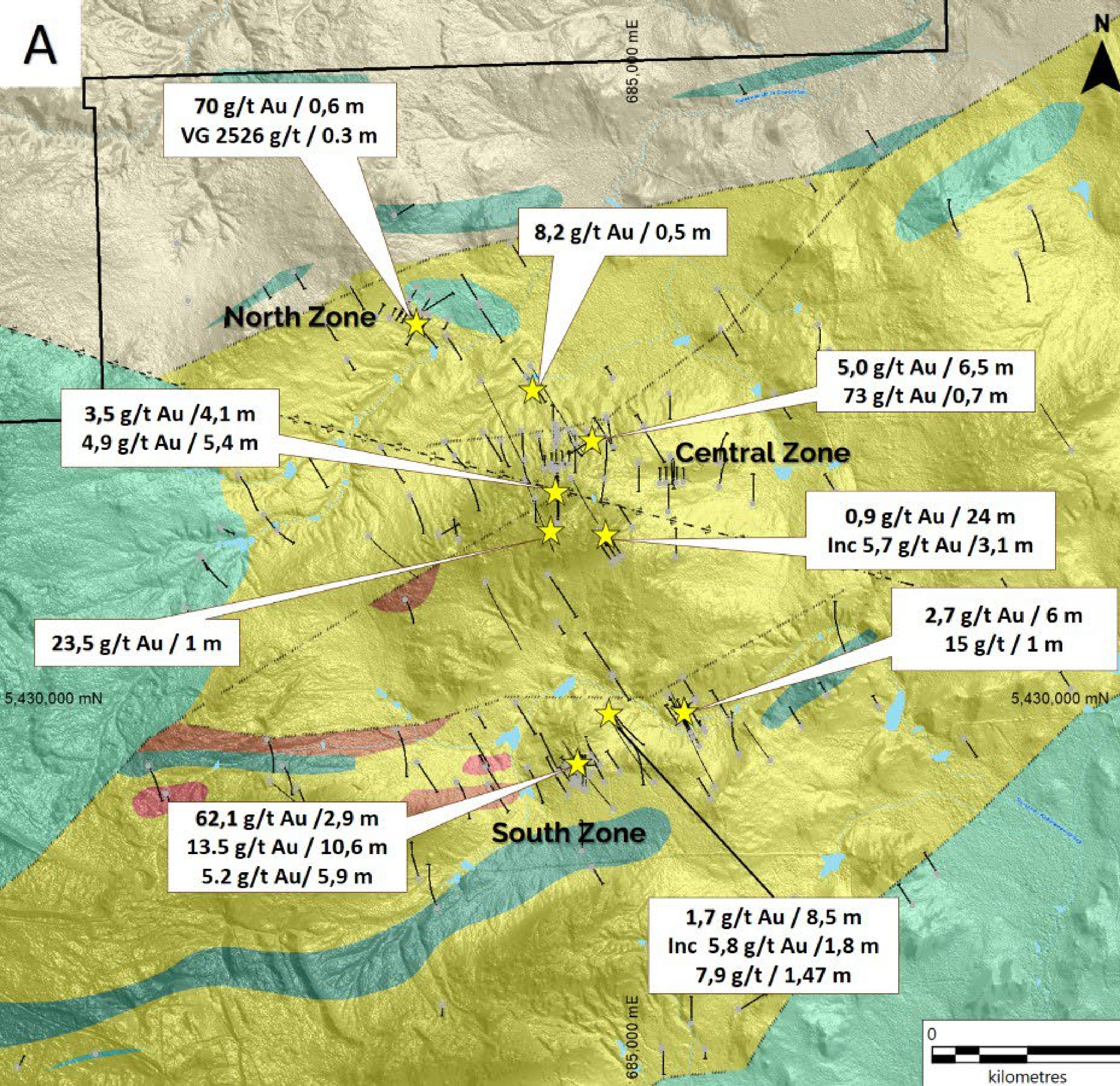
LIGNERIS: HISTORIC DRILLING RESULTS



- Economical drilling intercepts that includes **13.5 g/t Au over 10.6 m.**
- Very little work carried out outside known areas.
- North and Central zones are dominated by Au-quartz veins (structurally controlled)
- South Zone shows similarities with Au-VMS type deposit (Laronde type)

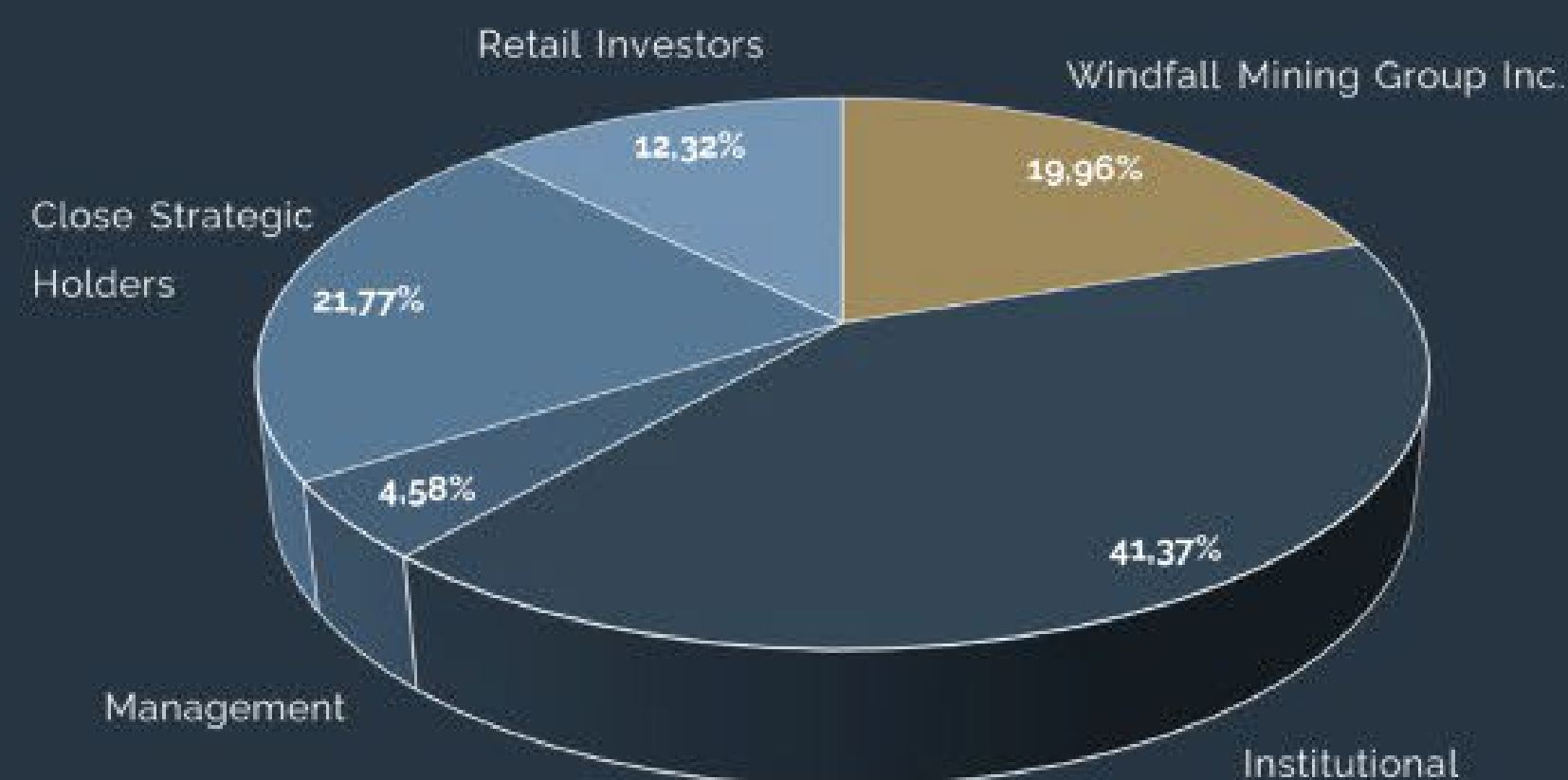

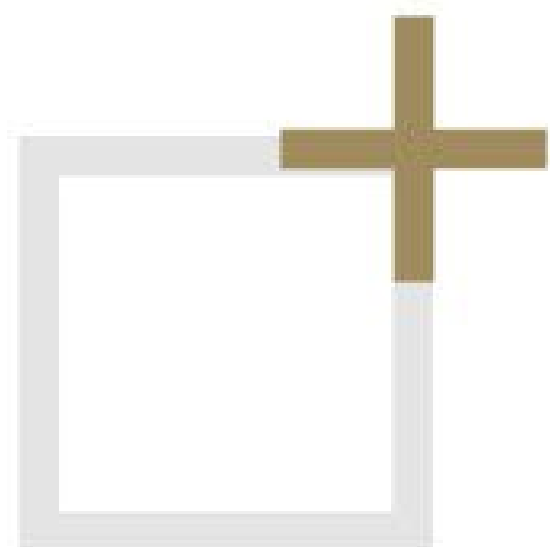
